Overview of the Board

Introduction:

iological diversity is the variability among living organisms and their habitat including diversity within species, between species and of the ecosystems. Biodiversity is the vast array of plants and animals including the insects and micro-organisms inhabiting the earth. Human civilization depends directly and indirectly on this diverse group of plants and animals for meeting basic needs of survival - food, fodder, fuel, fibre, fertilizer, timber, medicines and raw materials. This diversity is the prerequisite for long term sustainability of the environment and continuity of life. All over the globe people are now conscious and concerned about habitat degradation, accelerated loss of species and diminishing local traditional knowledge.

The growing concern for depletion of biological diversity world-wide led to the establishment and adoption of the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) in 1992. This Convention recognizes the sovereign rights of the states over their biological resources. With this objective the Government of India enacted the Biological Diversity Act, in 2002. This Act provides for conservation of Biological Diversity, sustainable use of its components and fair and equitable sharing of the benefits arising out of commercial use of biological resources and associated traditional knowledge. At the national level, National Biodiversity Authority (NBA) oversees implementation of the Act. The State Biodiversity Boards (SBBs) are formed at state level and Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC) are constituted by the local bodies to decentralize the implementation of the Act.



Assam State Biodiversity Board:

In exercise of powers conferred under sub-section (I) of Section 22 of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 (Act 18 of 2003), the Government of Assam constituted the "Assam Biodiversity Board" on 29th September 2010 to promote biodiversity conservation, sustainable use of its components besides equitable sharing of benefits arising out of the use of biological resources of the state and traditional knowledge associated with it.

Composition of the Board:

The Board is headed by a Chairman in the rank of Additional Chief Secretary to the Government of Assam. During the year 2013-14, Shri P. P. Varma, IAS and Shri S. C. Das, IAS, held the Chairmanship of the Board. Apart from the Chairman, the Board has six Ex-officio members from related Departments of Government of Assam and five Expert Members. The officer in-charge of Biodiversity in the Forest Department is the Member Secretary to the Board.

Functions of the Assam State Biodiversity Board:

Without prejudice to the provisions of the Act in general, the Board has following functions:

- To lay down procedure and guidelines to govern the activities under section 23 of the Act;
- ii. To advise the government on any matter concerning conservation of biological diversity, sustainable use of its components and fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising out of the use of biological resources and associated traditional knowledge;
- To provide technical assistance and guidance to the departments of the State Government;
- To regulate by granting of approvals or otherwise, on requests for commercial utilization or bio-survey and bio-utilization of any biological resource by Indian Nationals;
- v. To facilitate in updating and implementation of State Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan;

- vi. To constitute expert committees consisting of experts and persons having local knowledge, commission studies and sponsor investigation and research;
- vii. To engage consultants for a specific period, not exceeding three years, for providing technical assistance to the Board in the effective discharge of its functions: provided that if it is necessary and expedient to engage any consultant beyond three years, the Board shall seek prior approval of the Government for such an engagement;
- viii. To collect, compile and publish technical and statistical data, manuals, codes and guidelines relating to conservation of biological diversity, sustainable use of its components and fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising out of the use of biological resource and knowledge;
- ix. Inventorization, cataloguing of biodiversity, monitoring the rate of depletion, awareness creation in public, decision makers and planners and initiating scientific, administrative, legal and socio-economic measures for the protection of biodiversity;
- To compile a database on the biodiversity resources in the State,
- Development of state wide strategy for implementing biodiversity programmes;
- To identify the natural habitat of useful biological communities by enlisting the services of the locally available experts;
- xiii. Preparation of an exhaustive inventory of the species available in the natural habitat of useful biological communities and take steps to preserve them,

- xiv. To take steps to build up database and to create information and documentation system for biological resources and associated traditional knowledge through biodiversity registers and electronic database to ensure effective management, promotion and sustainable uses;
- xv. To devise methods to ensure protection of rights including intellectual property rights over biological resources and associated knowledge including systems of maintaining confidentiality of such information as appropriate including protection of information recorded in People's Biodiversity Register;
- xvi. To ensure that biodiversity and biodiversity dependent livelihoods are integrated into all sectors of planning and management and at all levels of planning from local to state to enable such sectors and administrative levels to contribute effectively for conservation and sustainable use;
- xvii. To plan and organize training programmes for personnel engaged or likely to be engaged in programmes for the conservation of biological biodiversity and sustainable use of its components;
- xviii. To generate public awareness for conservation of biological diversity, sustainable use of its components and fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising out of the use of biological resource and knowledge;

- xix. Setting up sufficient infrastructure and strengthening technology base in biochemistry and biotechnology including molecular systematizer;
- xx. Preparation of annual budget of the Board incorporating its own receipts as also devolution from the Central and the State Governments and the National Biodiversity Authority;
- xxi. To recommend creation of posts to the Government for the effective discharge of functions by the Board and to create such posts:
 - a. Provided that no such posts of any nature, whether temporary or permanent, shall be create without the prior approval of the Government,
 - To approve the method of recruitment to such posts;
- xxii. To co-ordinate the activities of the Biodiversity Management Committees,
- xxiii. To give directions to Biodiversity

 Management Committees in writing and
 through appropriate oral means for effective
 implementation of the Act and to facilitate
 their meaningful participation in all
 measures relating to conservation,
 sustainable use and equitable benefit sharing,
- xxiv. To report to the Government and the National Biodiversity Authority about the functioning of the Board and Implementation of the Act,

- xxv. To recommend, prescribe or modify collection fee of biological resources from time to time;
- xxvi. To sanction grants-in-aid and grants to the Biodiversity Management Committees for specific purposes;
- xxvii. To undertake physical inspection of any area within its jurisdiction in connection with the implementation of the Act;
- xxviii. To do such other functions as may be directed by the State Government from time to time.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES OF THE BOARD DURING THE YEAR 2013-14

Reconstitution of the Board

In continuation of the Government Notification issued vide no. FRW. 57/ 2005/311 dated 29/9/2010, the Government of Assam reconstituted the Board and extended the tenure of the Expert Members for a further period of 3 (three) years with effect from 29. 9. 2013 vide notification no FRW.57/2005/367 dated 25/10/2013 (Annexure –I). Further, the Principal Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Panchayat and Rural Development Department or his representative was included as Ex-Officio Member in the Board.

Human Resource Issue:

- a. Committee for HR Issue: In terms of the decision taken in the 9th Board meeting held on 29/10/2013, a Committee was constituted comprising of the following for making assessment of Human Resource requirement of the Assam State Biodiversity Board, suggesting recruitment Policy and Recruiting Rules:
 - Dr. R. M. Dubey, Chairman-SPCB Chairman
 - Dr. P. C. Bhattacharjee, Member-ASBB Member
 - iii. Sri M. K. Yadav, CCF (RE & WP) Member

- b. The Committee on HR issue of the Assam State Biodiversity Board met at the Board office on 3rd January 2014 and prepared a draft service regulation for the employees of the Board that was approved by the Board in its 11th Board meeting held on 06/05/2014 and later submitted to the Government for approval.
- c. The draft Service Regulation of the Board was submitted to the Government of Assam, Environment and Forests Department, Dispur for consideration and approval.

Creation of Posts:

A proposal was initially moved to the Government during April 2012 for creation of specific posts in the Board. After recommendations of the HR Committee a revised proposal was submitted to the government which is under consideration.

Amendment to Assam Biodiversity Rules 2010:

A proposal from the Board for Amendments to the Assam Biodiversity Rules- 2010 was submitted to the Government in March 2012. During the pendency of this proposal certain Amendments were suggested by the NBA, Accordingly, a consolidated amendment proposal has been submitted which is under consideration by the Government.

Sensitization Workshops:

a. Zonal level workshop on Biodiversity for Sensitization of Stake holders:

Following sensitization workshops were organized during the year 2013-14:

- i. 4th June, 2013: Zonal workshop for the Districts of Golaghat, Jorhat, Sivasagar, Dibrugarh and Tinsukia was held at Assam Agricultural University, Jorhat in collaboration with Eastern Assam Circle of Forest Department.
- ii. 23rd August, 2013: Zonal workshop for the Districts of Kamrup (Metro), Kamrup (Rural), Barpeta, Nalbari and Goalpara was held at Assam Forest School, Jalukbari, Guwahati in collaboration with the Central Assam Circle of the Forest Department.
- iii. 18th September, 2013: Zonal workshop for the Districts of Cachar, Karimganj and Hailakandi was held in Silchar in collaboration with the Southern Assam Circle of the Forest Department.
- iv. 23rd September, 2013: Zonal workshop for the Districts of Nagaon, Morigaon, Sonitpur, Lakhimpur and Dhemaji at Tezpur in collaboration with the Northern Assam Circle of the Forest Department.
- v. 13th February, 2014: Zonal workshop for Karbi Anglong Autonomous Council was held at Diphu in collaboration with Forest Department.

In these workshops more than 250 delegates including senior government officers from Civil Administration, Forest, Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries and Education Departments, Research and Training Institutes, representatives of Panchayats, Prominent NGOs and Eminent Citizens of the respective districts participated.

b. Divisional Level workshop for sensitization of the BMC Members:

 A Divisional level workshop was held on 18/03/2014 at the Range Forest office, Nalbari for sensitizing the BMC members of North Kamrup Division about the Biological Diversity Act-2002 and Assam Biodiversity Rules-2010 and the Role of the Biodiversity Management Committees in implementing the Act.

Celebration of International Biological Diversity Day.

With a view to generating awareness about biodiversity the Board organized celebrations of International Day for Biological Diversity at Guwahati on 22nd May 2013 on the theme "Water & Biodiversity".

- i. Hon'ble Minister of Environment and Forests, Panchayat & Rural Development-Assam, Shri Rakibul Hussain was the Chief Guest at the function. About 150 Delegates including senior government officers from Forest, Panchayat, Agriculture, Horticulture, Fisheries, Education Departments, representatives of Educational and Research Institutes, prominent NGOs, Presidents and Members of Anchalik Panchayats of Kamrup district, school children and eminent citizens attended the function.
- ii. The Chief Guest, Hon'ble Minister (E & F) released two publications:
 - a. "Bengali Version of the Biological Diversity Act 2002 & Assam Biodiversity Rules, 2010" and
 - b. "Glimpses of Biodiversity in Assam".

iii. Painting and Quiz competitions for school children were held on 19th May, 2013 at Assam State 200. About 800 school children participated in these competitions. The winners of these competitions were presented with trophies and certificates at the function.

Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC):

In terms of Rule-25(1) of the Assam Biodiversity Rules 2010, and with a view to empower local people, Biodiversity Management Committees (BMCs) are to be constituted by the local bodies. Accordingly, the Board constituted 141 BMCs during 2013-14 covering 16 Districts namely Kamrup, Nagaon, Morigaon, Darrang, Golaghat, Sonitpur, Sivasagar, Dibrugarh, Tinsukia, Nalbari, Barpeta, Lakhimpur, Dhemaji Cachar, Karimganj and Hailakandi. A list of the BMCs are given at Annexure-II.

Strengthening of Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC):

The Board has taken up measures to strengthen and operationalize BMCs across the State. With this view, during the Year 2013-14, financial assistance was provided to for the following:

- Organizing Divisional and Sub-divisional level awareness workshops for capacity building for members of BMCs- Rs. 20,000/ has been provided to each Forest Division.
- Opening of Accounts for the BMCs to be operated jointly by the Chairman and Member Secretary of BMC.
- iii. Setting up of office of the BMCs within existing Panchayat office - financial assistance of Rs. 5000/BMC has been provided for acquiring office essentials.

People's Biodiversity Register (PBR):

- a. Nagaon District PBR: After competitive bidding the Society for Socio-Economic Awareness & Environment Protection (SSEAEP), Nagaon has been assigned the works for preparation of People's Biodiversity Register of Nagaon District by selecting at least 5 Anchalik Panchayats.
- b. Digital Database: The Board with the help of AMTRON has developed, a Digital Format for the State Level Biodiversity Database. This database is proposed to be linked with PBRs for generating information both for conservation of biodiversity and for disposal of proposals seeking access to biological resources in the State. Field trials are proposed in the next financial year.

Projects Undertaken:

In terms of the approval of the Board in its 6th Meeting a research project on "Identification & documentation of spider fauna of Kaziranga National Park" was launched. The work duration was from September 2013 -May 2014 (9 months).

Permissions sought/granted:

The Biological Diversity Act and the Assam Biodiversity Rule regulate access to biological resources, and prescribe manner in which the access could be allowed. The Assam Biodiversity Board received several applications seeking access to biological resources for various purposes. The Board has approved the following applications in the year 2013-14:
